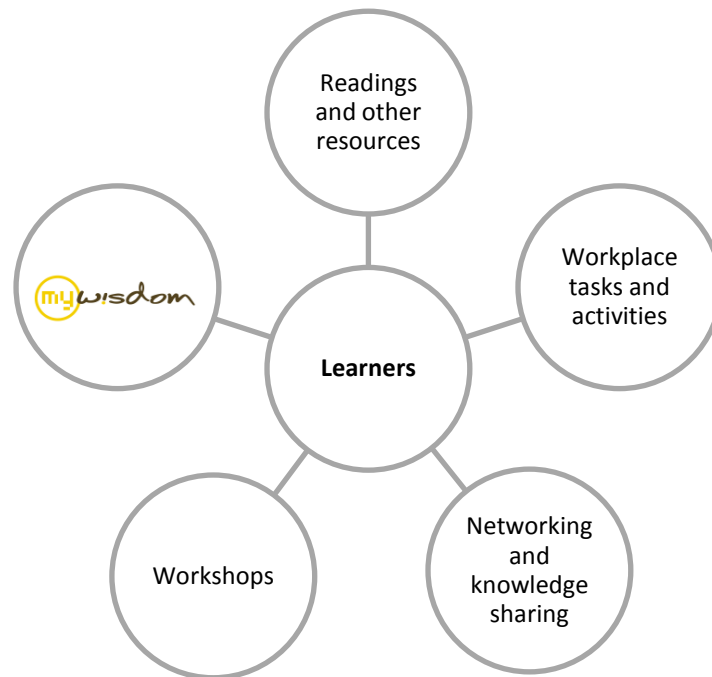


Wisdom Way Learning Model
